

Minutes: August 17, 2009 Ozark Mountain Anglers Bass Club

Opening: The meeting was held at the Elks Club. Meeting was called to order at 6:30 P by President Gilpin.

Present: about 25 club members

Approval of Minutes: The previous meeting minutes were read and approved.

Treasurer Report: Don Adkins, Treasurer gave the following report:

Reminder: Classic Location was voted upon at previous meeting and Lake Ozark – Purvis Beach will be the location of the Classic on October 10 and 11, 2009. Hours will be 7A to 4P on day 1 and 7 A to 2 P on day 2. All of Lake Ozark will be off limits on Monday through Thursday prior to the tournament.

New Business: Sport Show information was shared with the members. Board and Officers have been exploring the possibilities of moving the sport show to the Boone County Fairgrounds. Costs are projected to be lower than Hearnes. The fairgrounds location has a fixed fee (\$4,500 rather than a fee based on square footage and axles). Fairgrounds will allow us to sell and take tickets, provide security, sponsor or run a beer garden, allow archery, and firearms. We would not be able to have the concession (they will run one) and we would have to rent tables from them, but there would not be an extra charge for electricity. Club was advised that if we had the event at the new location more time would have to be required of the membership (estimated to be 7 or 8 hrs per member) to perform the additional duties. A letter is being sent to vendors requesting feedback on whether they think they would be willing to participate. President Gilpin asked for members to indicate yea or nay on proceeding with plans to have the sport show. Majority indicated that they wanted the club to proceed.

Drawing was held for the August 22, 2009 Truman tournament. Tournament hours are 6:30 A to 3:00 P – going out of Sterrett Ramp. The draw order follows.

Meeting was adjourned at about 7:10 PM – Minutes taken by Ernie Barbee.
